


PERFORMANCE OF THE INSTITUTION IN ONE AREA DISTINCTIVE TO ITS
PRIORITY AND THRUST

Udalguri College was established on the 20th of August 1979 due to the urge of the people of the area who had been without an institution for higher education. It is located approximately 22kms from the international boundary with Bhutan and the interstate boundary with Arunachal Pradesh. Presently it is the only provincialized UG College (Bodo had been introduced for PG from the session 2021-22 with affiliation to Bodoland University) located in the district headquarter of Udalguri which falls within the jurisdiction of the Bodoland Territorial Region (BTR). Being a rural area during its inception, the rural populace was the most affected as they could not get their wards admitted to far of places as Udalguri lacked a higher educational institution then. The priority which led to the establishment of the college was thus to help the marginalized sections educated. Udalguri College is proud to serve the rural students who form the majority in the College.

The majority of students are from Scheduled Tribe (more than 65%), while students from OBCs, SC and the General section of the population too get admitted in the College. A noted feature of the enrolment ratio is that female students (more than 50%) comprise the majority of students getting admitted in the College. The College thus has been rendering yeomen service in initiating women empowerment through education. The College being situated in a multi-cultural area, the students community reflects unity in diversity that India represents. Students from diverse linguistic communities such as Bodo, Assamese, Rabhas, Gorkhas, Santhali, the Tea Tribes, Bengali, Hajong, Garo etc get admitted in the College.
