### Analysis on Students' Feedback on Courses

Udalguri College, Udalguri

For the Session: 2022-2023

A survey was conducted to take feedback from the Students of Udalguri College, Udalguri for the session 2022-23, by the Feedback Cell of the college on various aspects such as the syllabus covered in the class, communication skills of the teachers, interest generated by the teachers in the classroom, availability of resources in the college library, knowledge base of the teachers, sincerity/commitment of the teachers, accessibility of the teachers in and out of classrooms, opportunities provided by the college, teachers' approach to teaching, health and hygiene system of the college, use of ITC tools such as LED projectors, multimedia by the teachers in the classrooms, encouragement given by the teachers to take part in extra-curricular activities, support from administration during admissions, examinations, registrations and other fields, overall quality of teaching-learning process etc. based on the experience of the students at the college. The survey was conducted through feedback using Google Forms by providing an online questionnaire to the students containing a total of twenty (20) questions. Seven hundred thirty-one (731) students participated in the survey.

The feedback obtained from the students on the course was analysed and is presented below-

- (1) Out of 731 Students, 17.1% are highly satisfied with the progress of the syllabus covered in the class while 58.7% of the students are satisfied; 21.2% of students feel that it is average; 1.8% of the students are dissatisfied and only 1.2% of the students are highly dissatisfied.
- (2) 48.6% of the students feel that the teachers are always effective in communication with the students; 24.8% of the students opine that teachers are sometimes effective in communication; 19.7% of the students think that the communication skills of the teachers are satisfactory; 3.7% of the students opt that communication skill of the teachers are generally ineffective and 3.3% of the students feel that the communication skill of the teachers is poor.
- (3) Out of 731 students, 17.1% of the students feel that the interest generated by the teachers is excellent; 30.5% of the students feel that it is very good; 48.6% of the students feel that it is good; 2.7% of the students feel that it is fair and only 1.1% of the students rate it as poor.
- (4) 13.7% of the students feel that the availability of resources for the courses in the college library is excellent, 23.7% of the students feel that it is very good; 52.1% of

- the students feel that it is **good**; 4.57% of the students feel that it is **fair** and only 6% of the students rated it as **poor**.
- (5) Out of 731 students, 11.8% of the students feel that the overall support from Udalguri College library in pursuing their courses is excellent;24.9% of the students feel that it is very good;53.2% of the students feel that it is fair and only 5.7% of the students rate it as poor.
- (6) 24.6% of the students feel that the knowledge base of the teachers is excellent; 32.7% of the students feel that it is very good; 40.1% of the students feel that it is good; 2.1% of the students feel that it is being fair and only 0.5% of the students rate it as poor.
- (7) 21.2% of the students strongly agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow; 54.4% of the students agree; 19.8% of the students are neutral; 2.9% of the students disagree and only 1.6% of the students stronglydisagree.
- (8) Out of 731 students, 18.5% of the students feel that the sincerity/commitment of the teachers is excellent; 15.7% of the students feel that it is very good; 61.4% of the students feel that it is good; 3.3% of the students feel that it is fair and only 1.1% of the students rate it as poor.
- (9) 34.7% of the students rate the accessibility of the teacher in and out of the classroom as every time; 32.7% of the students rate it as usually; 23.9% of the students rate it as occasionally/sometimes; 4.5% of the students rate it as rarely and only 4.1% of the students rate it asnever.
- (10) 37.1% of the students think that the institute takes active interest every time in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students; 13.57% of the students think that the institute often takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students; 35.8% of the students think that the institute sometimes takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students;7% of the students rate it as rarely and only 6.6% of the students rate it as never.
- (11) 42.3% of the students think that the teachers can identify fully the strength and encourage them with the right level of challenges; 26.9% of the students think that the teachers can identify reasonablythe strength and encourage them with the right level of challenges; 16.3% of the students think that the teachers can identify partiallythe strength and encourage them with the right level of challenges; 11.4% of the students think that the teachers can identify slightly the strength and encourage them with the right level of challenges; 3.1% of the students think that the teachers are unable to identify the strength and encourage them with the right level of challenges.



- (12) Out of 731 students, 18.9% of the students feel that the teacher's approach to teaching is best described as excellent;29.8% of the students feel that the teacher's approach to teaching is best described as very good; 47.5% of the students feel that the teacher's approach to teaching is best described as good; 2.5% of the students feel that the teacher's approach to teaching is best described as fair and only 1.49% of the students rated it as poor.
- (13) 13.5% of the students feel that the health and hygiene system of the institute is excellent; 26.1% of the students rated it as very good; 49.8% of the students rated it as good; 4.7% of the students feel that the health and hygiene system of the institute is fair and 5.9% of the students rate it as poor.
- (14) 38.6% of the students feel that every time the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications; 35.8% of the students feel that the teachers usually illustrate the concepts through examples and applications; 18.9% of the students feel that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications occasionally/sometimes; 3.7% of the students feel that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications rarely and only 3% of the students feel that teachers never illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.
- (15) 29.5%of the studentsstrongly agree that teachers encourage the students to participate in extracurricular activities;50.2% of the students agreed, 16.7% of the students were neutral, 2.5% of the students disagreed and only 1.1% of the students strongly disagreed.
- (16) Out of 731 students, 17.9% of the students feel that 90% and aboveteachers use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching;29.3% of the students feel that 70-89% of the teachers use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching;28% of the students feel that 50-69% of the teachers use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching; 12.3% of the students feel that 30-49% of the teachers use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching and 12.4% of the students feel that the percentage of teachers who use ICT tools such as LED projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching is below 29%.
- (17) 19.8% of the students strongly agree that the institute makes an effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process;53.8% of the students agree;21.2% of the students are neutral;3.3% of the students disagree and 1.9% of the students strongly disagree.
- (18) Out of 731 students, 38% of the students feel that every time the teachers inform the students about their expected competencies, course outcome and programme

PRINCIPAL UDAL GURI outcome;31.6% of the students feel that the teachers usually inform the students about their expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcome;23.1% of the students feel that the teachers inform students about their expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcomeoccasionally/sometimes;5.4% of the students feel that the teachers inform students about their expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcomerarely and 1.9% of the students feel that teachers never inform the students about their expected competencies, course outcome and programme outcome.

- (19) 14.4% of the students think that the support from the administration on admission, registration, examination and other fields is excellent; 27.4% of the students rate it as very good; 46.5% of the students rate it as good; 4.9% of the students feel that it is fair and 6.8% of the students rate it as being poor.
- (20) 23.1% of the students strongly agree that the overall quality of the teaching-learning process in the institute is good;52.5% of the students agree;18.9% of the students are neutral;3.6% of the students disagree and only 1.7% of the students strongly disagree.

 Are you satisfied with the progress of the syllabus covered in the class till now-731 responses




How well were the teachers able to communicate?



3. Interest generated by the teacher-



4. How do you rate the availability of resources related to your course in Udalguri College library ? 731 responses




How do you rate the overall support of Udalguri College library in persuing your course ?


### 6. Knowledge base of the teacher-


#### 7. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow-


#### 8. Sincerity/commitment of the teacher



9.. Accessibility of the teacher in and out of the class-731 responses




10.. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students-




11.. The teachers identify your strenghts and encourage you with providing right level of challenges-







# 12. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as-




# 14. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications-





15. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities-




16. What percentage of teachers use ICT toos such as LED projector, Multimedia, etc, while teaching-

17. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process-




18. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes-




19. Your opinion on the the support from administration on admission, registration , examination and other fields-

#### Action to be taken:

After analysing the feedback received from the students, it has been found that the following actions should be taken to improve the teaching-learning process-

- (a) More attention is required to complete the syllabus within the stipulated time.
- (b) Adequate resources for all courses should be available in the college library.
- (c) The overall quality of the teaching-learning process should be improved.
- (d) Teachers should encourage the students to take part in extra-curricular activities.
- (e) College should provide multiple opportunities to the students.
- (f) Health and hygiene system of the college should be improved.

### **Concluding Remarks:**

The feedback received from the students on courses indicates that most of the students are satisfied with the progress of the syllabus covered, the communication skills of the teachers, the interest generated by the teachers, the knowledge base of the teachers, sincerity/commitment of the teachers, accessibility of the teachers in and out of the class. 53.8% of the students agree that the institute tries to engage students in the monitoring, review, and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process; 54.4% of the students agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow; 42.3% of the students think that the teachers can identify fully the strength and encourage them with the right level of challenges. They agree that the sincerity/commitment of the teachers is satisfactory. The overall feedback received from the students on the course is satisfactory.
